MIHAELA PLESA ANNOUNCES RUN FOR TEXAS HOUSE DISTRICT 70

Experienced Legislative Director and Lifelong Texan Seeks to Represent Constituents from Newly Drawn House District in Collin County

Collin County, TX – Mihaela Plesa, Democratic candidate for Texas House of Representatives House District 70, announces her candidacy for the newly drawn district which encompasses parts of North Dallas, Richardson, Plano and Allen. Plesa is an experienced voice in Austin with many legislative accomplishments and offers institutional knowledge of policy making.
